

**2016 Yukon River Fall Salmon Fishery News Release # 40
Yukon River District 1 Commercial Period 15
Districts Affected: Lower Yukon Area
Emergency Order # 35**

District 1 Commercial Fishing:

Commercial fishing will be open for one period in the **Set Net Only Area** of District Y-1 on Wednesday, August 24 from 1:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. This will be a 9-hour commercial fishing period for the **Set Net Only Area** with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh.

The remainder of District Y-1 will be open to commercial fishing on Wednesday, August 24 from 4:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. This will be a 6-hour commercial fishing period with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh.

Verbal reports from the District 1 commercial opening on August 21 indicate a preliminary harvest of 17,337 fall chum and 13,927 coho salmon. The cumulative commercial harvest in District 1 to date is 181,724 fall chum and 39,751 coho salmon.

District 1 Subsistence Fishing:

Subsistence salmon fishing in District 1 is open during the fall season 7 days per week, 24 hours per day with gillnets restricted to a maximum mesh size of 7.5 inches, except for 12 hours before, during, and 12 hours after each commercial fishing period. **For this short notice period, subsistence salmon fishing in District 1 will close at 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 24, and reopen at 10:00 a.m. Thursday, August 25.** Fishermen may use 4-inch or smaller mesh size gillnets to target non-salmon species during subsistence salmon closures.
