FEB Tropical Storm Weather Advisory for Monday September 11, 2017

The Federal Executive Board advises that **FEDERAL OFFICES** in the Metro Atlanta Area will be CLOSED on Monday September 11, 2017. Metro Atlanta Area Federal Agencies should not to report to their worksite but should implement their Unscheduled Telework and Unscheduled Leave Policies as outlined by their agency's policy.

On <u>Sunday September 10</u>, 2017 the National Weather Service issued a Tropical Storm Warning for The State of Georgia North due to Hurricane Irma and extreme weather conditions that included high winds of 50-60 miles per hour, flash floods, and 3 to 5 inches of rain, throughout Metro Atlanta and Central Georgia. Extreme caution should be exercised throughout the metro area during this storm.

We will continue monitoring the weather conditions for Metro Atlanta and will update our advisories as require by changes in the weather conditions.

Teleworkers are expected to work their full workday schedule or take leave if unable to Telework. Use of Telework should be based on individual Agency policies. If you have questions about your Telework and Leave Policy please contact your specific agency representative.
