Hi Randy,

A few comments from NPS:

- General comment: there is inconsistency in capitalization of "monument" in both reports
- BENM report:
  - p7, paragraph on timber: change "Christmas tress" to "Christmas trees"
  - p8, second paragraph under "Multiple Use, Tradeoffs among Permitted Activities, and Types of Economic Information" heading: consider adding public safety as a consideration when making tradeoffs. Could insert "public safety considerations" somewhere in these two sentences: "Factors that could inform these tradeoffs include demand for the good or activity, prices, and societal preferences. Other considerations might include the timeframe of the activity - how long the benefits and costs of a given activity would be expected to extend into the future."
  - p8, third paragraph under "Multiple Use, Tradeoffs among Permitted Activities, and Types of Economic Information" heading: consider pulling information from table 3 to describe natural and cultural resource relevance in decision making (all other activities from table 3 are described in this paragraph).
- Interim report:
  - p3, table on monuments being reviewed to determine whether adequate public comment took place: change "Katahden" to "Katahdin"

Will the Office of Policy Analysis draft a document similar to the BENM report for each of the monuments under review?
