The system is a set of tools similar to a spreadsheet or statistical package. We do not pre-program actions by users, rather, the user executes functions, for example, like the search function we used to isolate the Bears Ears comments.

This will need to be done for all the monuments one at a time. Presumably we need to get a new bulk extract from FDMS, ingest it, and deduplicate it.

One question is: how often do you want to repeat this set of steps?
