VI. Weekly Report:

Week Ahead Schedule of Meetings, Hearings, and Travel

The week of December 11, BLM Office of Law Enforcement and Security Director William Woody visit members and staff of the Utah congressional delegation to discuss law enforcement issues in Utah. BLM Deputy Director for Policy Brian Steed and DOI Director of the Office of Congressional and Legislative Affairs John Tanner also plan to attend.

Week Ahead Announcements and Actions

On December 12, BLM-NV will hold an online oil and gas lease sale for 208 parcels totaling 388,959.402 acres in White Pine, Lincoln and Nye Counties. The sale will likely be controversial. Nevada has received comments from the EPA, Center for Biological Diversity, Great Basin Water District and Nevada Department of Wildlife, regarding a variety of concerns including impacts to air quality, water resources, and sensitive species.

On December 12, BLM-MT will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 204 parcels totaling 98,889 acres in Big Horn, Custer, Carter, Fallon, Garfield, Powder River, Richland, and Rosebud Counties. BLM-MT expects minimal controversy with this sale. Bidding is not expected to be robust.

On December 12-13, the Fort Berthold Federal Partners Meeting will take place in Lakewood, Colorado. BLM Montana/Dakotas Deputy State Director/Division of Energy, Minerals and Realty Don Judice; Eastern Montana/Dakotas District Manager Diane Friez; and North Dakota Field Manager Loren Wickstrom will attend. The meeting will address ongoing issues and challenges associated with Bakken development of oil and gas on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation.

On December 12, BLM-UT will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 75 parcels totaling 94,000 acres in Duchesne, Uintah and Emery counties. The sale is expected to be controversial due to the nomination of parcels near Dinosaur National Monument. However, two of the three parcels nominated by industry for consideration near the boundary of the Dinosaur National Monument have been deferred by the BLM Utah State Director for further consultation with the National Park Service. The remaining parcel contains both BLM and split estate land, and has a small portion within view of the Monument. The portion of land within view of the Monument is privately owned, however, the BLM has applied stipulations for light and noise pollution, and to minimize impacts to air quality and the scenic viewshed. Bidding is expected to be robust.

On December 13, BLM-CA State Director Jerry Perez will meet with Avangrid Renewables LLC to discuss right-of-way fees and fair market values for the Tule Wind Project. The company maintains that the regulatory basis for the Tule Wind Project's acreage rent does not fairly reflect actual fair market values for land within the project area. The BLM requested additional information from Avangrid to support its position and for further discussion of this matter.

On December 13, BLM-CA Bakersfield Field Office will host an informational meeting and site visit for tribes regarding a Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act case at the San Joaquin River Gorge. Last year, human remains were discovered due to erosion on the slope of trail. The site has been stabilized to prevent further erosion. The meeting will discuss the tribes' wishes regarding this discovery and any future discoveries that may be made in the area. The North Fork Rancheria of Mono Indians,

which is a federally recognized tribe, has request official government-to-government consultation on this case, which will be scheduled separately from this informational session.

On December 13, the BLM-CA El Centro Field Office will conduct a public scoping open-house meeting as a first step in the preparation of a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for United States Gypsum Company's (USG) proposed mine expansion/modernization project near the city of El Centro. The quarry is located about 26 miles northwest of Plaster City. Both sites are located within the BLM's California Desert Conservation Area. USG's proposed mine project involves the Plaster City Wallboard Plant and Plaster City Quarry.

On December 14, BLM-Eastern States will hold an oil and gas lease sale for seven parcels totaling 1,185 acres in OH and LA. The sale will include five parcels totaling 350.06 acres in the Wayne National Forest, Monroe County, OH; and two parcels totaling 834.70 acres in the Kisatchie National Forest, Natchitoches and Winn Parishes, LA. The parcels being offered in the Wayne National Forest are expected to be controversial as several environmental groups are attempting to prohibit hydraulic fracturing in the area. At this time, the level of bidding interest is unknown.

On December 14, BLM-UT will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 75 parcels totaling 94,000 acres in Duchesne, Uintah and Emery Counties. The sale is expected to be controversial due to the nomination of parcels near Dinosaur National Monument. Two of the three parcels nominated by industry for consideration near the boundary of the Monument have been deferred pending consultation with the NPS. The remaining parcel contains both BLM-managed and split estate land, with a small portion in view of the monument. The BLM, however, has applied stipulations for light and noise pollution, and to minimize impacts to air quality and the scenic view shed. Bidding is expected to be robust.

On December 14, BLM-CA's Bakersfield Field Office will host a public scoping meeting in Three Rivers to gather comments on a draft of a vegetation/forest health plan for the BLM's only giant sequoia grove on Case Mountain. The BLM manages approximately 444 acres on Case Mountain, which supports the Giant Sequoia Complex and the Case Mountain Extensive Recreation Management Area. The area is also part of the 20,000-acre Kaweah Area of Critical Environmental Concern, designated for the protection of the six distinct giant sequoia groves, other sensitive plant and animal species, riverbank ecosystems and culturally significant areas.

On December 14, BLM-AK Associate State Director Ted Murphy will provide an update to the Western Arctic Caribou Herd Working Group on development activities within the NPRA-A. The group brings a broad range of stakeholders together who are actively involved in the management of caribou and includes subsistence users, other hunters, reindeer herders, hunting guides, transporters and conservationists.

On December 14, BLM WY will host an online oil and gas lease sale. The sale will offer 45 parcels totaling 72,884.37 acres located in Laramie, Lincoln, Sweetwater, and Uinta counties. BLM received three protests for this oil and gas lease sale that will be dismissed because the issues raised in the protest are adequately analyzed in the supporting NEPA documents and Resource Management Plans. One protest from the Upper Green River Network, Department of Geography, University of Wyoming, expressed concern that some parcels being offered at the sale were close to pristine tributaries to the Green River, in Greater Sage-grouse habitat, and posed potential groundwater contamination from hydraulic fracturing. A protest from WildEarth Guardians claimed that BLM failed to conduct a conformity analysis for the lease sale, failed to adequately analyze and assess the climate impacts, and that BLM should have used the Social Cost of Carbon Protocol in their NEPA review. The final protest from The Wilderness Society on behalf of the Wyoming Outdoor Council and the National Audubon Society claims the BLM failed to adequately provide for conservation of Greater Sage-grouse under the approved land use plans for some parcels located within priority habitat management areas. This is the

first sale that BLM-WY is not deferring the vast majority of parcels in Priority Habitat Management Areas, which has caused a higher than usual level of interest; however, the actual sale is not expected to be controversial and bidding is expected to be average for an oil and gas lease sale in the High Desert District.

On December 15, BLM-CA Bakersfield Field Office will meet with the California Resources Corporation (CRC), the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to discuss CRC's proposal to donate its mineral estate in the Carrizo Plain National Monument in exchange for mitigation credit for projects conducted in the San Joaquin Valley. The BLM is strictly a facilitator for these meetings and does not anticipate having to make a decision.

30 - 60 Day Look-Ahead

On December 22, the BLM-CA Central Coast Field Office intends to sign the decision record for the Trio Jacalitos Canyon Application for a Permit to Drill in Fresno County, CA. This is the first APD completed in the Central Coast Field Office since the Hollister litigation and settlement agreement required the BLM to complete an Environmental Impact Statement to further analyze the impacts of oil and gas leasing and development, specifically enhanced well stimulation and hydraulic fracturing, within the boundaries of the Central Coast Field Office. While the EIS has not been finalized, the BLM is moving forward with this APD due to the fact that it is proposed as a conventional well. This APD is likely to draw the attention of environmental organizations. This APD has been on hold since 2013 when BLM identified the need for additional inventory. The BLM review was reinitiated in 2017 when the proponents provided notice that the additional inventories were being completed. Public notification for the proposed APD was posted on the BLM's National NEPA Register on Oct. 2, 2017.

On January 6 - 8, BLM will host a meeting to develop an interagency strategy to contain the spread of quagga mussels from the Lower Colorado River at the Colorado River District/Lake Havasu Field Office in Lake Havasu, AZ. Development of this strategy was identified as one of the Department of the Interior's top priorities to prevent the introduction and spread of invasive mussels in the June report to the Western Governors Association.

On January 8, BLM-CO will attend the Western States Land Commissioners Association (WSLCA) Winter Meeting in Denver. The WSLCA is an organization representing 23 state land management agencies that together manage more than 440 million acres of surface and subsurface state lands throughout the central and western U.S. The BLM has an MOU with the WSLCA to advance the long-term goals of both the BLM and member states by resolving state-Federal land exchanges and other appropriate realty actions.

On January 31, BLM-CA staff will participate in an oil and gas operator seminar that focuses on surface and environmental requirements associated with new oil and gas projects (Applications for Permits to Drill (APDs) and Sundry Notices). On average, the BLM is able to permit APDs in a 30-45 day period, due to assistance from operators in getting needed information to the BLM in a timely manner. The BLM will provide seminar participants a refresher on the items the BLM needs regarding biological, cultural, and paleontological reviews to ensure a quick turn around when new permits are submitted.

In February 2018, the BLM-CA Bakersfield Field Office staff will participate in a U.S. Forest Service lead public meeting in Fillmore about four Applications for Permit to Drill in the Sespe Oil field. USFS is the lead agency on the NEPA analysis. This meeting will generate public interest. Previously, BLM-CA had received inquiries from Congresswoman Julia Brownley's (CA-26-D) office.
