### Purpose:

To exercise the authority under FAR 18.201 and 41 U.S. Code §1903, to increase certain acquisition thresholds for Department of the Interior (DOI) procurements in support of major disaster response-Hurricane/Post Tropical Storm Harvey.

### Scope:

In using the increased thresholds, this authority applies only to procurements supporting Hurricane Harvey in the major disaster area, as defined in and as may be subsequently amended in the Presidential declaration. Any purchases using this authority must have a clear and direct relationship to the support of this major disaster. The contracting officer shall document the connection to Hurricane Harvey response/recovery in the disaster area when using these increased thresholds.

The major disaster area is subject revision as the storm moves along the Gulf Coast. As the geographic area of the Presidential declaration is revised (to be shown at the FEMA disaster [webpage](#) listed under FEMA DR-4332), the geographic area applicable to the threshold increases in this memorandum is simultaneously revised without a revision to this memorandum.

### Effective date:

This policy is effective upon signature and will remain in effect until December 31, 2017, unless otherwise rescinded or modified.

### Background:

On August 25, 2017, President Trump issued Major Disaster declaration in the State of Texas as a result of Hurricane/Post Tropical Storm Harvey. These declarations invoke Emergency Acquisition Flexibilities authorized in Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 18 and 41 USC 1903 in support of the Federal response to the disasters and emergencies in the State of Texas.

**Action:**

Bureaus and offices must follow the procedures set forth in attached Class Determination and Findings (D&F) for acquisitions that support hurricane/post tropical storm Harvey response and recovery efforts.
