### Tribal Energy Subcommittee Wednesday, December 19th, 2018 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM EST Meeting Summary

## **DOI Update:**

- Secretary Zinke submitted his resignation. For the RPC it is business as usual and the work of the RPC remains a priority.
- The next RPC meeting will take place on January 31<sup>st</sup> in Phoenix. Sector meetings will take place on January 30<sup>th</sup>.
- The meeting format has been tweaked slightly, in response to feedback from the last meeting. There will be time to welcome new members to the committee. There will be a big block of time allotted for the TES specifically, the TERA Working Group to discuss the status of the TERA Recommendation. There will also be time allotted for someone from the Department (perhaps from the Office of the Secretary) to provide an update on the effort to develop the list of not inherently federal functions.
- Preliminary recommendations must be submitted by January 3<sup>rd</sup> to be considered at the RPC meeting.

# **TERA Working Group Update**

- The TERA Working Group:
  - Will present at the meeting on the  $31^{st}$ .
  - Is awaiting the Office of the Solicitor list of not inherently federal functions.
  - Held calls related to the Amendments to the Indian Tribal Energy Development and Self Determination Act of 2005 and how those will impact the work of the RPC. S245 was signed by the President on December 18<sup>th</sup>.
  - Will pull together language from S245 and propose a recommendation for review by the TES and, potentially, to submit to the RPC for consideration at the meeting on January 31<sup>st</sup>. It is likely that the recommendation will request that the Secretary take a closer look at inherently federal functions – and do so in a way that calls for adequate and meaningful Tribal Consultation.

### **Model Statute Working Group**

• The Working Group is preparing something to distribute and discuss at the RPC meeting on the 31<sup>st</sup>. This will be an initial draft. Thirty minutes should be sufficient for the initial discussion.

## **1938 Act Working Group**

• No update at this time.

## **Taxation Working Group**
