The Western Interior Alaska Subsistence Regional Advisory Council is scheduled to meet October 11-12, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the McGrath Native Village Community Service Center in McGrath, Alaska.

The Council will discuss proposals to change Federal subsistence fish regulations for the 2017-2019 regulatory years as well as other issues affecting subsistence in its region. The council will also discuss the Tongass Submerged Lands Proposed Rule.
