How Much Insulation Should I Add?

- Look across the span of your attic. If your insulation is just level with, or below, your floor-joists you should be across the span of your attic.
- Distribute insulation evenly, with no low spots; sometimes there is enough insulation in the middle of the
- Many air leaks and drafts are easy to find because they are easy to feel—like those around windows an
- Holes may be hidden in attics and crawlspaces.
- Seal leaks with caulk, spray foam or weather stripping.
- You don't need to be a pro to know the proper insulation levels and insulation depth.
- Insulation levels are specified by R-Value, a measure of insulation's ability to resist heat flow.
- Add the Right Kind of Insulation
  - The higher the R-Value, the better the thermal performance of the insulation.
  - We recommend a wall-insulation level of R-15.
  - We typically recommend attic-insulation level of R-38, or about 12 to 15 inches, depending on insulation
  - Today's homeowner has many types of insulation to choose from. Avoid common insulation mistakes w
  - When adding insulation, you don't have to use the same type of insulation that currently exists in your a
  - If you use fiberglass over loose fill, make sure the fiberglass batt has no paper or foil backing; it needs to
