Subject: Methow Valley State Airport Closure

Area of Concern: All Aviation Operations

Discussion: Methow Valley State Airport (S 52) will be closed to the public on May 14, 2018, to begin a pavement rehabilitation project for the airport's only runway (13/31). The anticipated completion of the project is early July 2018. North Cascade Smokejumpers will operate out of nearby airports as necessary throughout the closure period. Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) Aviation will issue an airport closure and Notice to Airmen (NOTAM). The airport's Automated Weather Observation Station (AWOS) will remain operational through this period.
