Resolution JEMCO 2018-: Pohnpei Utilities Corporation Institutional Reform

The JEMCO acknowledges progress made by Pohnpei Utilities Corporation (PUC) in implementing the early stages of PUC's Multi-Donor Framework for a Capitalization, Recovery and Institutional Strengthening Program (CRISP).

JEMCO resolves that the commitments by the Pohnpei State Government and the Pohnpei Utilities Corporation as contained within the CRISP shall be applied as special grant terms and conditions to Compact sector grants provided to the Government of the FSM in support of the CRISP.

JEMCO further resolves that \$1,328,220 is allocated to the Public Infrastructure Sector in support of the CRISP (\$828,220 - power generation engine overhaul and \$500,000 - three-phase metering expansion). Prior to the drawdown of funds, a preliminary schedule for implementation of the CRISP commitments must be submitted to the Office of Insular Affairs.
