**RESOLUTION JEMFAC 2018- 1 Special Grant Terms And Conditions**

Mid Corridor Housing Project (MCHP): JEMFAC resolves that up to \$354,000 is allocated from the Kwajalein Impact Fund for 90% design of the MCHP and to hire a professional community housing development planner to assist the GRMI in the preparation of a fully developed Mid Corridor Housing Project implementation plan consistent with recommended guidelines in the May 8, 2018 letter between JEMFAC Members.

JEMFAC further encourages that the Mid Corridor Housing Project be designed, constructed, operated, and maintained to provide the greatest possible benefit to the people from the Mid-Atoll Corridor.

JEMFAC resolves that the basis of design for the Mid Corridor Housing Project (including materials, specifications, and methodology of construction), shall meet or exceed design standards utilized for Compact-funded public infrastructure sector projects within the RMI for buildings, structures, and attendant infrastructure.

JEMFAC further resolves that the GRMI will address outstanding issues from the May 8, 2018 letter from the U.S.JEMFAC members to RMI JEMFAC members on an expedited basis.

JEMFAC further resolves that the allocation of \$1,500,000 (Stage 1) for the Mid-Corridor Housing project will be made available to the GRMI upon satisfying all of the conditions stated above.

Ebeye Water Supply and Sanitation Project (EWSSP): To ensure the financial and operational sustainability of Kwajalein Atoll Joint Utilities Resources, JEMFAC resolves that the installation of a prepayment metering system is required for all water connections installed under the EWSSP in order to assist in the maintenance and operation of the capital infrastructure constructed under the EWSSP.
