Regional Advisory Council membership application deadline extended through March 1, 2019

The deadline for submission of applications to fill seats on the 10 Subsistence Regional Advisory Councils has been extended. Applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2019. Council membership appointments are typically for 3-year terms. There are 41 seats open for appointment among all Councils.

The Councils meet at least twice a year and provide advice and recommendations to the Federal Subsistence Board on subsistence management issues. Council meetings serve as a forum for public involvement in Federal subsistence management. Council members must be knowledgeable about the uses of fish and wildlife resources in their region.

Individuals may apply for membership themselves, or an individual or organization may nominate someone for Council membership.
