Noncompetitive Formula Grant Programs


- State Historic Preservation Offices
 - Annual funding for 59 SHPOs
 - Funds work in 8 program areas defined by the NHPA
 - Administration, CLG, Development, National Register, Planning, Survey & Inventory, Tax Incentives
 - 10% of State funding must be distributed to Certified Local Governments
- Tribal Historic Preservation Offices
 - Annual funding for 195 THPOs
 - Funds work in program areas adopted through MOA with NPS
- Grants last two years, two active grants ongoing
- Fund the operations of offices and their implementation of the NHPA on behalf of the NPS



African American Civil Rights

- Grants to document, interpret, and preserve sites and stories related to the African American Civil Rights movement in the 20th century
- No match required
- Projects types include preservation, pre-preservation, and history projects
- Eligible applicants include States, Tribes, local governments, and non-profit organizations



Historically Black Colleges & Universities

- Grants to assist HBCUs repairing National Register listed buildings on their campuses
- Over \$40 million awarded through 2006
 - FY2017 \$4 million
 - FY2018 \$5 million
 - FY2019 \$8 million
- Applications due February 4, 2019
- No match required

Historic Revitalization Subgrant Program (HRSP)

- Physical preservation of NRHP listed and eligible sites
- Awarded as block grants to be subgranted
 - FY2018 \$5 million
 - FY2019 \$5 million
- Applications likely available early Spring 2020
- No match required
- Funds must be spent in rural areas < 50,000 as defined here:

Tribal Heritage

- Since 1990 more than \$17 million has been awarded to over 460 Indian, Alaskan Native, and Native Hawaiian communities
- Grants to assist in protecting and promoting unique cultural heritage and traditions
- Applications due Spring 2019.

Projects include: oral histories, survey, inventory, education, interpretation, and preservation.

- Funds surveys of historic properties associated with underrepresented communities, as well as nominations to the National Register for specific sites
- \$25-50,000 grants
- No match required
- \$500,000 available for past 5 years,
 - FY2019 \$750,000
- Applications due November 2019
- SHPOs, THPOs, CLGs may apply

Save America's Treasures

- For the preservation and conservation of **nationally** significant buildings and collections
- Managed in partnership with NEA, NEH, and IMLS
- Eligible applicants include states, tribes, local governments, and non-profit organizations
- Projects funded in all 50 states, DC, and the territories

Save America's Treasures

- From 1999 to 2010 over 3,600 applications requested \$1.45 billion
- \$300+ million to over 1,200 projects since 1999
- 1:1 match required
- Since refunded:
 - FY2017 \$5 million
 - FY2018 \$13 million
 - FY2019 \$13 million
- Applications likely due December 10, 2019

HIM: Emergency Supplemental Historic Preservation Fund for Hurricanes Harvey, Irma, Maria

- Grants to assist disaster affected States and Tribes
- \$50 million appropriated in FY2018
- Awards have been made to Texas, Louisiana, Georgia, South Carolina, Puerto Rico, USVI, Seminole, and Coushatta tribes

FYM: Emergency Supplemental Historic Preservation Fund for Hurricanes Florence, Michael and Typhoon Yutu

- Grants to assist disaster affected States and Tribes
- \$50 million appropriated in FY2019
- Awards made to Alabama, CNMI, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Virginia
