Subject: Re-Delegation of Suspending and Debarring Official Authority

DELEGATION. The Interior Delegations Manual provides, in part, that “In addition to the delegations contained in 212 DM 11.3.B., the Director, Office of Acquisition and Property Management (PAM), is delegated, through the Deputy Assistant Secretary – Budget, Finance, Performance and Acquisition and Senior Procurement Executive, the authorities described below. . . B. The Director is authorized, in accordance with applicable provisions of the DIAR, to make certain determinations and approvals as required by the Federal Acquisition Regulation and implemented in the DIAR. The provision does not include a re-delegation prohibition.

The DIAR Part 1409 Supplement to FAR 9.4, identifies the Director, Office of Acquisition and Property Management as the Departmental Suspending and Debarring Official. The same authority designation exists for actions taken under the parallel government-wide discretionary nonprocurement suspension and debarment system under Office of Management and Budget “Guidelines to Agencies on Government-Wide Debarment and Suspension (Nonprocurement)”, implemented by DOI at 2 C.F.R. Part 1400.

This memorandum re-delegates from the PAM Office Director, to the PAM Debarment Program Director, all suspending and debarring official responsibilities under 48 C.F.R. Subpart 9.4, as supplemented by DIAR Part 1409, and 2 C.F.R. Part 180, implemented by Part 1400.

AUTHORITY. 48 C.F.R. Subpart 9.4 and Part 1409; 212 DM 11.3; and 2 C.F.R. Parts 180 and 1400.

RESTRICTIONS. This delegation may not be further delegated and may be rescinded at any time.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This delegation of authority is effective upon signature and remains until rescinded.
