Montana Visualization Mock-Up Presentation by IA

- IA has been working with 18F to ensure proposal is feasible for 18F to implement.
- Mock-up based on outline and template that Subcommittee has already seen.
- Production data will show numbers, ranking among other states, and percent of US total.
- All links are to government sources.
- Many visualizations are static, due to user feedback and 18F's current capabilities.
- Will include cost information about water and reclamation (because MT has info on these).
- Luke to reach out to Mark Haggerty at Headwaters for feedback on this visualization.
- IA to add maps of revenue streams and distributions.
- Subcommittee should provide comments and feedback to IA by Thursday, April 21 (two weeks) – can send via email or set up a call with IA. Should solicit feedback from sectors as well.
