 - Includes data on all four categories: transportation, water, emergency services, and reclamation.

Tribe outreach

- Jerry to share draft Montana visualization with tribes as example of opt-in
- Jerry continues outreach to Osage Nation
- Southern Ute has confirmed that they will not participate at this time
- Julie has spoken with individual council members at Blackfeet and has positive feedback so far

- Will focus on same categories as last year: production, employment, revenues and costs
