Meeting Summary

Osage Update:

- Osage Minerals Council voted to proceed with USEITI
- There should be an article in Indian country
- They would welcome us coming out probably first half of July with some dates
- Jerry will follow up with Interior's Solicitor to get language for a legal release of data.
- ONRR does not have Osage data and will need to work with BIA
 - Jerry will let BIA know about Osage opting in, and the potential for BIA to release Osage data for the purposes of USEITI.

Alaska Update:

- State of Alaska has created a point of contact of USEITI, their chief economist
- Principal Dep. Assistant Secretary for the Interior will be meeting on Monday with the Lt. Governor of Alaska

Deloitte Update:

- Deloitte has updated its project plan to be reflective of the fact that some of the states and tribes will be in review after the June MSG meeting
- State and Tribal Narrative Updates
 - Montana is done
 - Wyoming had some data issues that was recently worked out with help from Wyoming staff.

County Updates:

- North Slope, Alaska
 - A bit of surprise that we do not have Governance as a category for the North Slope
 - However to add governance would go outside the agreed categories and need MSG approval.
- Data sources were the same as last year
 - Some data sources are slow to put out data and in some instances, they are behind in putting out their data.
- For additional information in some instances they had to use non-government sources
- Some counties there was the opportunity to add additional graphics
- Detailed feedback should be to Deloitte by May 31st
