

**2015 Yukon River Fall Salmon Fishery News Release # 33
Fall Announcement # 30, Yukon River District 1 Commercial Period 10**
Districts Affected: Lower Yukon Area

The 2015 fall chum salmon inseason run projection is on track for a run size between 700,000 and 800,000 fish. This level of abundance should be sufficient to provide for escapement, an above average subsistence harvest, and a surplus available for commercial and personal use purposes.

The estimated passage of fall chum salmon at the mainstem sonar near Pilot Station through August 21 is 431,000 fish, which is below the historical median of 513,500 fish for that date. The 2015 coho salmon run size is currently running average based on run reconstruction. As of August 21, the estimated coho salmon passage past the mainstem sonar is 46,000 fish, which is below the historical median of 70,700 fish for that date.

District 1 Commercial Schedule:

Commercial fishing will be open for one period in District 1, including the **Set Net Only Area**, on Sunday, August 23 from 4:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. This will be a 6-hour commercial fishing period with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh size.


Preliminary reports from the District 1 commercial opening on August 19 indicate a harvest of 12,769 fall chum and 11,358 coho salmon from 184 permit holders. The preliminary cumulative commercial harvest for District 1 is 87,931 fall chum and 43,548 coho salmon.

Subsistence Fishing Schedule: NOTE THE CHANGE IN THE SUBSISTENCE CLOSURE AREA.

For this short notice commercial fishing period, subsistence salmon fishing will close in District 1 at 1:00 p.m. Sunday, August 23, and reopen at 10:00 a.m. Monday, August 24. **In addition, the portion of Coastal District from Apoon Mouth to Point Romanof and marine waters up to 3 nautical miles offshore (see attached map) will close at 1:00 p.m. Sunday, August 23, and reopen at 10:00 a.m. Monday, August 24.**
