

**2015 Yukon River Fall Salmon Fishery News Release # 42  
Fall Announcement # 37, Yukon River Districts 1 and 2 Commercial Period 13  
Districts Affected: Lower Yukon Area**

The 2015 fall chum salmon inseason run projection is on track for a run size between 700,000 and 800,000 fish. This level of abundance should be sufficient to provide for escapement, an above average subsistence harvest, and a surplus available for commercial and personal use purposes. Inseason assessment is currently in line with the estimated run size for fall chum salmon, and the coho salmon run appears to be above average.

**District 1 Commercial Period:**

Commercial fishing will be open for one period in District 1 on Wednesday, September 2 from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. This will be a 6-hour commercial fishing period with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh size.

**District 2 Commercial Period:**

Commercial fishing will be open for one period in District 2 on Wednesday, September 2 from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. This will be a 6-hour commercial fishing period with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh size. **District 2 commercial fishermen need to confirm their market and identify the location of tenders prior to fishing.**

The preliminary cumulative commercial harvest for District 1 is 99,822 fall chum and 64,298 coho salmon. District 2 commercial harvest is 69,386 fall chum and 43,426 coho salmon. Total preliminary harvest for the lower Yukon Area during the fall season is approximately 169,200 fall chum and 107,700 coho salmon.


**Subsistence Fishing Schedule:**

Subsistence salmon fishing in Districts 1 and 2 is open during the fall season 7 days per week, 24 hours per day with gillnets restricted to a maximum mesh size of 7.5 inches, except for 12 hours before, during, and 12 hours after each commercial fishing period. In District 1 and 2, subsistence salmon fishing will close at 2:00 a.m. Wednesday, September 2, and reopen at 8:00 a.m. Thursday, September 3.

**NOTE THE CHANGE IN SUBSISTENCE CLOSURE AREA: In addition to District 1, the portion of Coastal District from Apoon Mouth to Point Romanof and marine waters up to 3 nautical miles offshore (see attached map) will close at 2:00 a.m. Wednesday, September 2, and reopen at 8:00 a.m. Thursday, September 3.**
