Subject: Memoranda in Effect

1. Environmental Statement Memoranda (ESMs) provide complementary information and guidance to bureaus and offices of the Department to ensure compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA), as amended. National Environmental Policy Act compliance follows the order of precedence below:

- a. Council on Environmental Quality regulations at 40 CFR 1500 *et seq.*,
- b. Department of the Interior regulations at 43 CFR Part 46,
- c. Department of the Interior policy at 516 DM,
- d. Department of the Interior guidance provided in ESMs.

2. This office issues ESMs as they relate to the general environmental compliance responsibilities of the Department (381 DM 4.5B).
